When you eat food that has been cooked using cast iron, over an open fire, you get a feeling for the turn-of-the-century way of life. The Ag Museum’s annual Chuck Wagon Cook-off shows skills that were used to keep the cowboys fed on the long trail drives during the 1880’s.



Judging begins on Friday, Feb 29th, when 15 wagons compete for the most authentic chuck wagon. The cook-off is Saturday, March 1st when the teams are judged for the best chicken fried steak, beans, bread, potatoes & fruit cobbler. The public can buy a meal ticket and eat from a wagon.

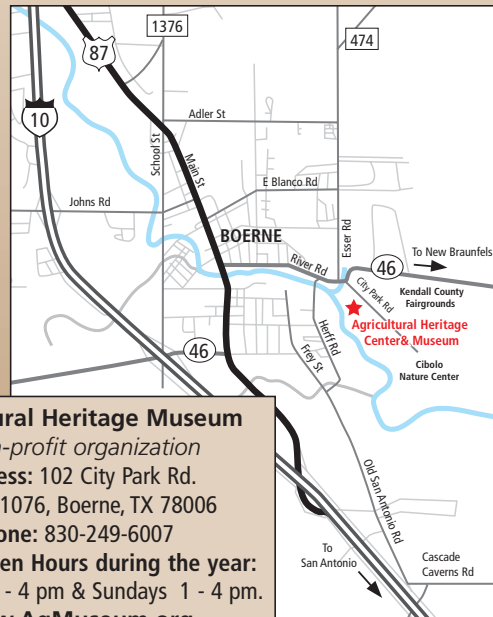
